
Payment info:

Account information is written on the Invoice please pay the deposit of 50% /person within 15 day/2 weeks after booking. The rest at the latest 7 days prior the camp star or could direct pay bay cash to us on the site

How to get the camp:

The trip star from Jakarta airport or Jakarta city or from Cimaja (west java) we could arrange to pick you up any time as you have flight schedule... Take approx 8 hours to reach the camp

- Land transport from Jakarta to boat port at west coast – Approx 4 hours
- Sea transport from boat port to the camp : Approx 4 hours



Air transportation

Jakarta can be reached by international flight from all over the world and also by domestic flight from **Bali, Lombok, Sumbawa, Sumatra, Padang**, as well as other domestic Indonesian ports. Mostly all airlines have daily flights so make sure you check with your travel agent. Keep in mind that cheap airlines charge a lot for boards so it pays to do your research before paying for your flight.

During the peak season of the year, it may be advisable to book your ticket a few days before you are planning, to go to make sure of getting on a flight

General Information:

1. Health / Risks:

You should take out comprehensive insurance with good medical cover in advance. Please note that travel insurance is within the personal responsibility of each traveler and should cover accidents, injury or loss of personal property!

Please consult your doctor in advance and discuss your individual medication (Tetanus and Hepatitis vaccination, anti-rabies inoculation) There are mosquitoes around Ujung Kulon but we have had no reports on malaria infection in recent years. A general health check with your doctor is an absolute necessity before travelling to the Java jungle and lies within the responsibility of each guest!

Please note that in and around Ujung Kulon National Park you will mostly be out in the wild involve certain risks and dangers. **(Please ask to our guide if you would like to do tour activity in the Jungle).** These include: Trekking in dense rainforest and wildlife observation ; unpredictable behavior of wildlife; accidents caused by the forces of nature; accidents or illness in remote regions with little or no medical facilities and without any means of rapid or free evacuation; accidents caused by Indonesian traffic. You should inform the Panaitan Surf Camp team about your personal health conditions like high blood pressure, allergies, operations, and fear of special insects, heights or darkness in advance!

In order to keep you as safe as possible you have to abide by the rules and instructions given to you by the Eco Surf team at all times. Please note that the tour operator is not liable for any damages or injuries suffered in consequence of anything, however caused, in connection with services carried out by third parties and for death or personal injury.

We recommended you bring basic form of first aid kit containing: **Q-tips (cotton buds), disinfectant (Betadine, povodine, klorhexidin. Etc) and waterproof plaster** , we do have a medical room at the camp but since medical supplies are hard to get we appreciate if you bring you own as well If you have any allergies, **please inform when you book so that we can give notice to our chef**

2. Visa:

Tourists can get a 30-day visa on arrival at Jakarta airport and on any other Indonesian international airports for \$25. If you want to stay longer you can get a 60-day tourist visa at the Indonesian Embassy. The exact process and documents required will vary depending on your nationality, the country you apply in and the kind of your stay in Indonesia. The validity of your passport should be 6 months from the date of arrival in Indonesia. More information you can get online at :

3. Money:

Make sure in advance to arrive with enough cash in the area of Ujung Kulon National Park! There are ATM machines on the way to the camp or you can find it in Jakarta airport and around but it is possible to change foreign money like Euro or Dollars! There are plenty of cash points in Jakarta where you can get money with credit cards or exchange foreign currencies into Indonesian Rupiah (IDR). Note: The maximum amount you get from ATM machines is 2.5 Million IDR, so you will have to make several transactions to get a higher amount! Due to frequent problems with ATM machines we recommend to take 2 -3 different credit cards with you!

4. Internet

We don't have internet access in the camp but you can find it at our office on mainland

5. Weather:

In Java there are only two seasons, a dry and rainy season. The rainy season lasts from November up to February and the dry season from April to October, with the transition periods characterized by capricious weather occurring in the months of March and October. Even in the middle of the wet season temperature could range from 23 degrees to 33 degrees Celsius, except at higher altitudes, which can be much cooler. The heaviest rainfall is usually recorded in December and January each year. But usually it is hot and humid around island. It tends to rain every few days, but normally not for a very long time also in the rainy season.
